- Have knowledge of the language, culture, and history of the Secwepemc Nation.
- Have demonstrated life or work experience relevant to the purposes of the Society.
- Be prepared to meet at least 4 times per year plus the AGM.

1. Representation at the Society Governing Level
2. Regional Coordination
3. Information Sharing
4. Input and Feedback
